



Setting up IPP Printing on a WT3000 terminal

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Summary

This technote describes how to setup IPP printing in WT3000 terminals.

Audience

1st Level Support, Product Support Group.

Requirements

Following conditions are required:-

- Printer must be IPP compatible
- JETCET Addon build 17 or higher

Steps to Perform

- Get into Control Panel of the terminal
- If the WT3000 has two Built-in COM ports double click on Ports icon and uncheck *Enable Com2*. (IPP uses dummy COM2 ports to communicate with clients like ICA or RDP)
NOTE: COM2 was selected as a way to overcome ICA limitations
- Click on the JETCET icon
- Click Properties...
- Select Internet Printing tab
- Enter the IP of the IP of IPP enabled printer
- Click Add Port.
*** You should see "IPP PRINTER PORT ADDED" message. If the message is "Invalid IPP Server" then the Printer is not IPP compatible and this printing will not work
- Click OK to save settings and close the JETCET applet
- Select RDP Icon (Client Printer icon for CE 5.x)
- Configure Printer for COM2: Do not configure for Network

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
